Year 8

Students experience as many facets as possible within the scope of our department. They will encounter QCAR core elements of Health and Physical Education. The main focus is developing student's knowledge and understanding of Health & Physical Education as well as providing a pathway for elective subjects available in year 9.

Year 9

Allows for more specific subject selection with allocations in Physical Education. They will encounter QCAR core elements of Health and Physical Education. The main focus is continuing developing student's knowledge and understanding of Health & Physical Education as well as providing a pathway for elective subjects available in year 10.

Year 10

Students may continue to study elective subjects from year 9. Year 10 is designed to prepare students for senior physical education subjects with a OP or Career focus. Subjects available in Year 10 include; Health & Physical Education, Sport Excellence and Rugby league Excellence programs.

Year 11 & 12

Students may choose from a variety of options that best serve their individual needs. The 3 subjects available in senior schooling include:
