PERFORMING ARTS OVERVIEW

This excellence program will develop your skills in the dimensions of drama, dance and singing. The course places you with like minded individuals and provides specialist instruction to develop you as a well rounded performer.

CURRICULUM

Within the **Drama** modules, you will engage in a variety of acting styles including Realism, acting for film and television, and non-naturalistic styles such as Physical Theatre and Comedy. You will experiment with creating and performing dramatic texts.

The **Music** component of the course focuses on vocal performance. You will explore styles such as Contemporary, R & B, Jazz and Musical Theatre developing a range of skills such as harmonisation, sight reading, microphone technique, ensemble and solo performance skills. There will also be opportunities for you to engage in song writing and composition.

In the **Dance** component of the course, you will learn the performance skills associated with a range of styles including hip hop, jazz and contemporary/lyrical. Learning experiences will focus on performance, choreography and appreciation.

This course will cater to your level of experience. You must have a desire to learn in all three dimensions of this course, majoring in one of these dimensions.
