\$548,000*

This funding will be used to

- Increase the school relative gain Year 7-9 to greater than 40 points in reading and writing.
- Increase the percentage of students in the Upper 2 Bands (U2B) to 15% for Year 9 reading.
- Achieve 100% QCE attainment and 100% Indigenous QCE attainment.
- Achieve 90% attendance.
- Enhance the support team to assist students to reach their potential.
- Facilitating access to technology in classrooms to enhance 21st century skills.

Our initiatives include

- Integrate technology to enhance programs utilising students' BYOD tablets and online programs.
- Employment of Teacher Aides with clear roles to track and support our students.
- Employment of Teacher Aide to track and publish significant outcomes.
- Build on the literacy and numeracy resources.
- Implement strategies to improve attendance for all students.
- Provide resources to compliment the growth of students in the U2B.
- Continue the Senior Outcomes team in the allocation of a coordinator.
- Providing targeted professional development.
- Participation in a pilot project to engage PBL Tier 3 students.
- Celebrate the success and growth of each student and the significant contributions by families.
