## This funding will be used to

- Junior Academic: Exceed 40% A-B / 80% A-C LOA in Yr 7-9 English, Maths, Science and Humanities.
- Junior Academic: Exceed 50pts relative gain in NAPLAN reading: Yr 7 to Yr 9.
- Senior Outcomes: Exceed 95% QCE attainment and 100% Indigenous QCE attainment.
- Senior Outcomes: Exceed 80% ATAR eligible students above an ATAR of 70.
- Student Support: Exceed 90% attendance.
- Student Support: Reduce Student Disciplinary absence to less than 40 per term per 1000 students.

## Our initiatives include

- Teacher Aides with clear roles to track and support our students in the Junior school.
- Integrate technology to enhance programs utilising students' BYOD tablets and online programs.
- Upgrade classroom technology.
- Allocate a coordinator of the Junior Academic Excellence program.
- Continue the Senior Outcomes team in the allocation of a coordinator.
- Industry Liaison Officer to enhance Vocational Education opportunities for Yr 10-12 students particularly at Cert III and above.
- Two Youth Support Coordinators to support students challenged in meeting school expectations.
- Teacher Aide to assist in the workload of Year level Deans.
- Attendance Teacher Aide to track student attendance, implementing school procedures.
- Celebrate the success and growth of each student and the significant contributions by families.
